Alison Erwood EHC Review Officer will manage EHCPs for children and young people at The Walnuts School and those in the South area

Karen O'Neil EHC Review Officer will manage EHCPs for children and young people at Romans Field School, Stephenson Academy, MK College and those in the Central area

Lai-Kwan Law EHC Review Officer will manage EHCPs for children and young people at Slated Row School and those in the North area
