- Our children are able to solve a disagreement by using their words through Restorative Practice
- All our children grow a plant from seed and can explain what it needs to grow
- Our children can hold a pencil effectively with tripod grip as a result of Story Dough,
 Funky Fingers sessions and Write Dance sessions
- Our children have developed a love for stories and this is demonstrated through all areas of our curriculum and family events, such as Books In The Woods and Books For Breakfast, Library sessions and our story bears
- Our children all experience a walk to local shops and amenities and show awareness of their local environment and community, and experience of running their own school cafe
- Our children take part in Expressive arts week and produce a piece of artwork for our school art exhibition
